Information about the post

We are seeking to appoint a dynamic, enthusiastic, talented and well-qualified ICT and Communications manager to join a successful and supportive ICT team to manage and develop the school's ICT Network (curriculum and administration) ensuring high quality support to both staff and pupils / students. The post is full time (37 hours per week). Candidates should have the right attributes to make a valid contribution to the wider school community.

The successful candidate will have excellent IT & Communications skills and experience. This is a key position within the support structure of the school. The candidate will be responsible for the day to day management of all aspects of the school's ICT systems including management of the telephony, CCTV, networks and school website to provide an efficient ICT function to the school. Knowledge of all aspects of School ICT systems and technologies, excellent time management and organisational skills, good literacy, numeracy skills are also essential. You will be responsible for the ICT team which includes ICT apprentices.

Our School

Judged by Ofsted as Good, Sir John Nelthorpe School is a fully inclusive mixed 11-19 voluntary controlled comprehensive school in the heart of North Lincolnshire.

In the 2019 GCSE results of particular note was the number of pupils achieving a pass grade (grade C) or higher in the academic group of subjects defined as the prestigious 'English Baccalaureate' (EBacc.). To achieve the EBacc, pupils must study English, Maths, Science, at least one Modern Foreign Language (French or German) and at least one Humanity subject (Geography or History). Sir John Nelthorpe has topped the County League Tables in this measure, ranking first place for pupils achieving a standard pass (grade 4) or higher and ranking in first place for those achieving a strong pass (grade 5) or higher.

When considering the performance of pupils whose GCSE grades represent the culmination of 5 year's hard work at this School, the GCSE "Basics" measure (recognising pupils who achieve a pass in both English and Maths) saw over 67% of pupils achieving the standard pass of grade 4 or better and over 48% of pupils achieving a strong pass of grade 5 and above. A remarkable pass rate of 100% was achieved in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Business Studies and Child Development. There were also very strong performances in Modern Languages and Technology subjects, along with PE and History.

At A Level, the performance of pupils within the Brigg Sixth Form has been excellent with all pupils securing the grades required to be able to progress on to their chosen universities (the vast majority of these being 'Russell Group' universities) or employer and apprenticeship routes. We are immensely proud of our year on year achievements and would love to hear from you if you feel you can help us on our journey to become outstanding.
