



## **School Bus information**

### **Catchment Area:**

Transport is organised by North Lincolnshire Council – Schools Transport. Parents need to apply for a bus pass using the application found on the North Lincolnshire Council website. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to go to the website to apply.

**Please note:** Parents are responsible for ensuring that pupils are at school. Good behaviour is expected of all pupils using school and public transport and should any pupil be banned from using buses as a result of poor behaviour, it is the parents' responsibility to make alternative arrangements.

If parents wish to collect pupils from school at 3.25 pm in the afternoon, they must not come on to the school site as it blocks entry for the buses. Parking is available on the Rec ground at Wrawby Road or the main public car park in Brigg.

Pupils are supervised on both sites whilst waiting for school buses.

If a pupil misses a bus they must not try to walk home. They should return into school and report to a member of staff. We will then ring a parent to make arrangements to get them home.
